

Evaluation

Catching fundamentals are good. Stays small and has a good set up. Tracks pitches well. Moves well. Frames the ball well. Pop times will come down with a quicker transfer and stronger arm. Just needs to keep working on bring that down around a 1.8. Defensively at 3B, has good glove skills. Backhand is solid. Moves well, just needs to get quicker laterally to improve her range. Work on making plays on the run. This requires specific footwork coupled with the ability to throw from a good arm slot. She is close on this play, it just needs to develop quicker and a stronger arm will help. She is a solid 3B prospect. Hitting mechanics are on the right track. She tends to wrap that load at times and subsequently rotates hard. This can produce power, but also make it hard to adjust to changes in speed and be consistent. Work on getting that foot down and being more linear early in her swing. The rotation will come closer to the point of contact or after. This will help her keep that inside pitch fair and go with the outside pitch to the opposite field.

ODM® Numbers

Numbers show some areas that need work over the next year or two. Needs to get quicker and stronger. A quicker, more explosive first couple steps will lower her 10 yard and 20 yard times. Has some speed once she gets going, but fades in the 40 yard. This is common for younger players that lack lower body and core strength. Shuttle time will improve with quicker turns and better footwork. As a C/3B that needs to be around a 5.2 in the next year or so. Bat metrics are good and will improve as she refines her swing. Bat speed needs to come up some. Hand speed and time to impact are a little slow. She maintains power through the ball, but that exit speed should be 5-10 mph higher than bat speed. Throwing velocity needs to improve some for her positions. Needs to be 60+ mph in the next year and 63+ after that. Broad jump will improve with additional lower body strength. Grip strength is good for her age. Left hand needs to improve some, especially as a catcher. Just needs some strength and conditioning work and that will have a positive impact on her game.
